The Great Barrier Reef is a natural wonder of the world and is a declared World Heritage site. It encompasses 350,000 sq kilometres of the South Pacific Ocean and is made up of 2,900 individual and 71 coral cays. Its ecosystem supports the greatest concentration of life on this planet including species of fish, 350 different corals, 4,000 species of molluscs and 10,000 species of sponges. Water temperature ranges from 22° to 28° Celsius (75° - 85°) allowing comfortable diving all year round.

For the certified diver or snorkeller our 3 day 2 night trip departs Cairns 6 times per week. This trip offers up to 11 dives and unlimited snorkelling. The PADI 5 day Learn to Dive course is broken down into two components:

2 days pool and classroom training

3 day 2 nights live-aboard cruise

The first two days are spent learning the theory and underwater skills of diving. The next 3 days are spent living on board one of our premium purpose built vessels. Your first 4 dives will complete your open water certification and then as a certified diver you are able to undertake up to 5 more pleasure dives. This includes a guided night dive! These dives will be exciting and truly memorable. The night of your return to Cairns, join the crew and fellow passengers for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

Minimum age is 12 years. No maximum age.

Dive medical in accordance with Australian Standard, A.S 4005-1. A fee of \$49.50 is payable directly to the doctor. This will be arranged by us day 1 of the course. Some medical conditions may prevent you from diving. For example: heart disease, asthma, epilepsy or diabetes. If you are unsure of a particular medical condition, please check with us prior to reservation.
